This tool was designed in Excel by finance experts, not coding gurus. Developing this as a web tool would take a tremendous amount of resources and time. On top of that, Alan needed to be able to make changes on the tool himself in the future, and share it with other partners.



The Solution

SpreadsheetWEB proved to be the best solution for this project, primarily because it could expedite the release process, allowed for development without any coding, and it's providing a scalable environment.

According to McMillan, the project was *"a terrific experience"*. From his perspective, *"Pagos could go ahead and host this calculator we built and offer it to the world, while protecting our IP and integrity of the tool itself. It's also flexible that if things change over time, we can implement these changes ourselves. It also allowed us to convert traffic. We could allow our users to get a report and enroll them in our blog and this turned out to be a significant growth for our site."*

Featuring an improved design and greater accessibility, the calculator was transferred to a web environment in only a few days.
